General Description: The Mental Health Therapist will provide individual and group mental health counseling sessions for students/clients of The Health Center. This position is approximately 33 hours per week. We follow the Walla Walla Public Schools schedule, which includes summers off, snow days, and general workdays between 8am-3pm.

Job Description:

- Provide individual and group mental health counseling for The Health Center clients consistent with standards established by the Washington State Department of Health and The Health Center policy.
- Complete required documentation (intake, visit notes, etc.) by the end of the next business day.
- Participate with The Health Center interdisciplinary team to provide mental health care recommendations for students and/or multi-disciplinary team meetings with outside agencies.
- Consult with primary care providers, teachers, school counselors, and other mental health professionals as needed.
- Make appropriate referrals as needed.
- Provide parent consultations and family support meetings for students as needed.
- Provide casemanagement, advocacy, and resource linkages.
